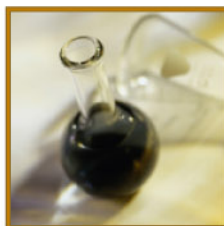

### Herb Quality Sourcing

Our premium-grade herbs are carefully selected and procured by highly reputable suppliers, whose skilled herbalists travel the world to source the best raw materials. They work with local, bio-regional farm communities. These communities have generations of experience cultivating and harvesting indigenous crops, using the most natural and traditional methods. This is done without the use of pesticides, sulfites or fumigation. Organic and ethically harvested herbs are always chosen whenever possible. These fresh raw herbs are carefully dried, identified and inspected, then promptly shipped to our US manufacturers.

Supporting Eco-Friendly agriculture and Fair-Trade practices preserves the local environments, the farmers and their ancient traditions of herb cultivation and processing. Our herbs are further examined by experienced herbalists and lab technicians. They carefully prepare and process the herbs to the highest quality standards supported by traditional and modern practices.



### Manufacturing

Our premium extracts are manufactured under strict quality controls using proprietary multi-phased, dual extraction systems. Our full-spectrum, liquid and powdered extracts are processed in water and or alcohol as appropriate to maximize the amounts and types of compounds extracted—always in accordance with traditional principles. The end product is a potent rich tea concentrate, alive with fragrant aromatics and volatile oils. The powder extracts use freeze dry and spray dry methods to remove all liquid elements and to obtain an highly concentrated fine powder, free of carriers or excipients.

### Concentration Ratio:

#### Fluid extracts:

The liquid tea concentrates use between 8-10 lbs of premium grade herbs to produce 1 gallon of extract. This equates to an 8:1 fluid extract concentration (lbs: gal) or 1:1 by metric standards (kg:ltr).

#### Powder Extracts

The carrier-free, powdered extracts range from 8:1 to 30:1 depending on the herb. The average concentration is 12:1. Standardization markers are given whenever applicable. To calculate concentration equivalency to raw herb dosage, use the specified extract ratio provided. For example, 1 gr of powder extract at a 10:1 potency equals 10 gr. of raw herb. Certificates of analysis are available upon request.

### Dosage guidelines:

#### Liquid extracts:

Strong dose: 1 tsp. (60 – 90 drops) in warm water as a tea, 2-3 x Day.

Mild dose: 1/4 - 1/2 tsp. (15 – 45) drops sublingually or in unchilled beverage, 2-3 x Day.

#### Powder extracts:

Use 1–3 grams per day (equivalent to 2–6 capsules of 500 mg).
